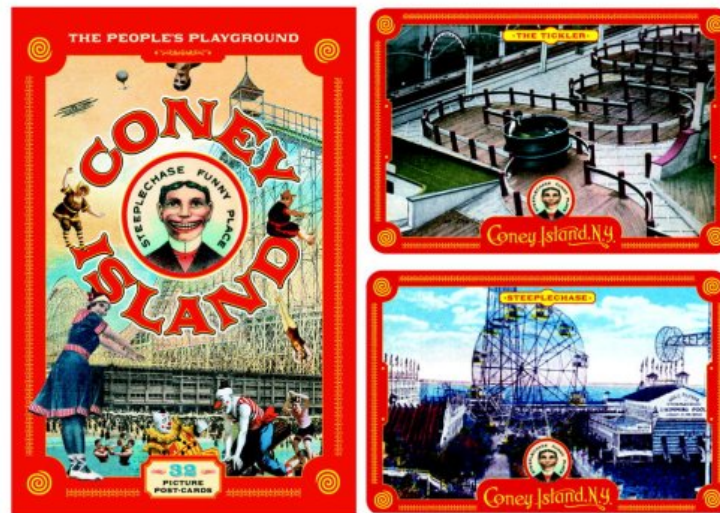

They are exceptionally well produced.The reason I gave 4 instead of 5 stars is that the cover says 32 cards but there are actually 16 different cards with two of each. This information is buried late in the overall description. Not a serious problem at the price, but it should be emphasized more obviously.Also, for TRIVIA sake, the artist should realize that Luna Park was a competitor of Steeplechase, which was George C. Tilyou's Coney Island venue. All of the cards have a design which implies that they are pictures of Tilyou's SteeplechaseAll that said, the cards are great, I love the 16 images.
