so my review of this is to be measured from that parameter. I purchased this book to use for reference in creating art based on German WW 2 soldiers, and I have found it to be an invaluable resource. Everything from boots to weapons to clothes, personal items including pamphlets for good soldiering, cigarette packs, soaps, etc. is included. I don't have the expertise to declare the information contained within to be always correct, nor can I attest to the book's thoroughness in exhibiting the artifacts used by the soldiers of Germany during the war. However, as a man who uses this to create art on the subject, I can attest to the fact that the book contains far more information and pictorial reference than I could have hoped for. This is a massive volume and was evidently put together and published with great care; it's simply a beautiful book. The photography is crisp and clean, the layout is pleasing to the eye.
