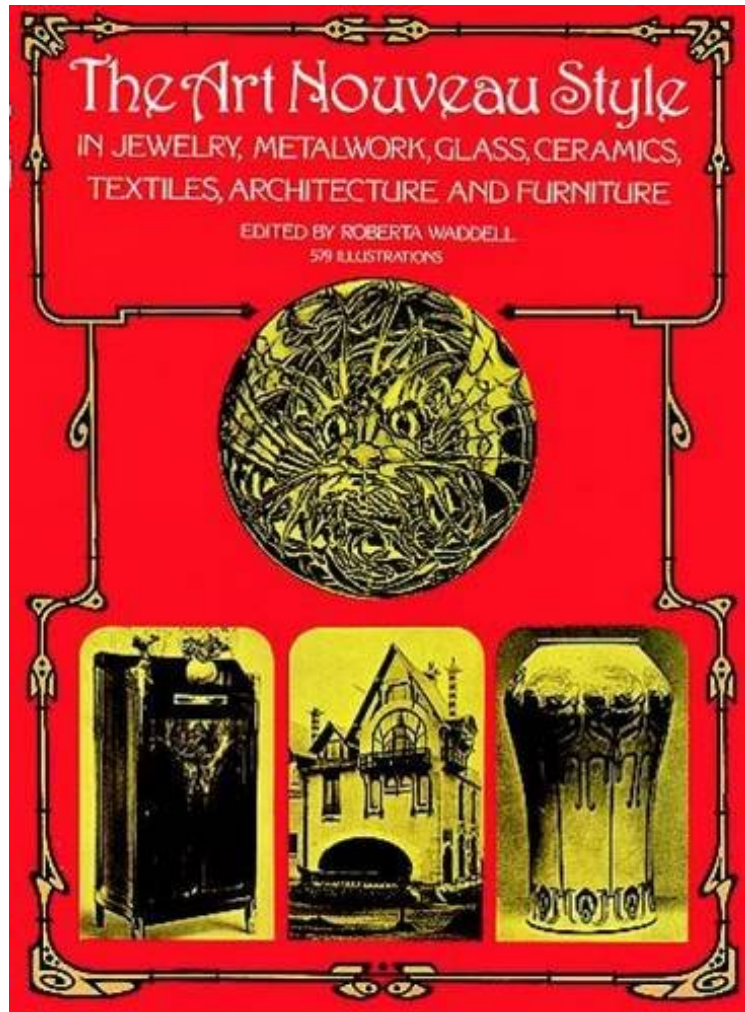

Editor Roberta Waddell includes photographs of objects ranging from pendants and buckles to stair-rails, chandeliers, and stained-glass windows, to decorative vases, textiles, and whole suites of furniture, to houses and World's Fair pavilions, all in the distinctive delicate, graceful Nouveau style. She lets the illustrations speak for themselves rather than trying to explain Nouveau in words, and if you're not too sure what the style constitutes, this is the book to get hold of. If, on the other hand, you're a fan and enjoy seeing pictures of the best examples of Nouveau, it's a volume you definitely should have on your shelves. Designers, social historians, and art lovers will all find it a valuable addition to their collections.
