The book itself is very high quality, and it is generously illustrated throughout with color photos. Dellar expands upon, and in some cases, corrects details from Robson. He includes both regulation and non-regulation patterns, as well as interesting histories of various sword makers (e.g., J.J. Runkel), information on sword blade decoration, yeomanry swords, etc. This is the most detailed examination of British cavalry swords to date. Its quality--both the book itself and the scholarship--is first rate. If you collect or have any interest in British swords you must buy this book! This book would also be an excellent addition to the libraries of museums that display British swords.
