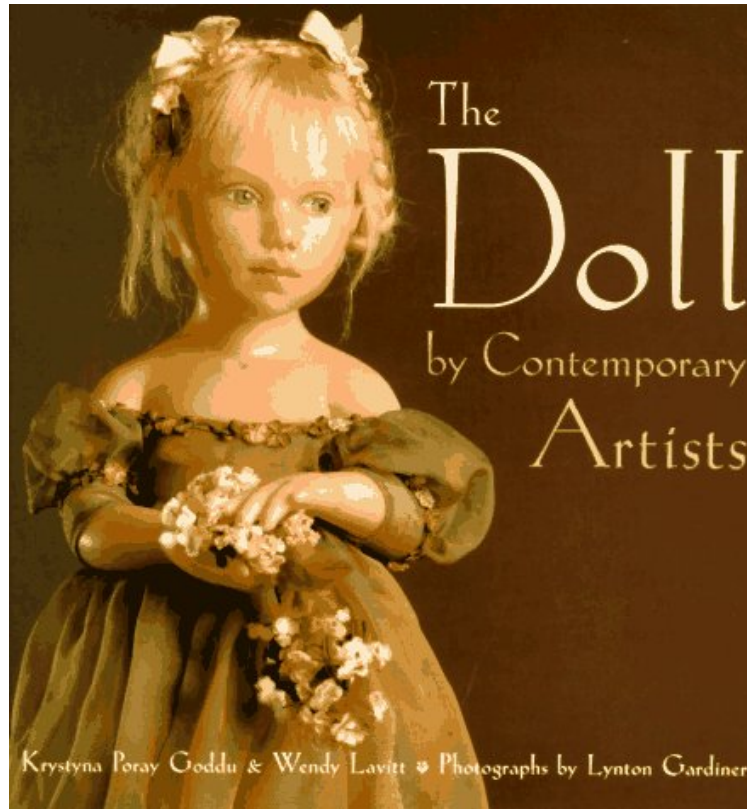

This is a very different kind of doll book than what I'm normally used to looking at. Not at all! The pictures in this book are creations that depict a very different kind of doll. These dolls are so unique that one would probably never see any of these mass produced. Not because they aren't good enough; no for the reason that they are ever more worthy for they are truly one-of-a-kind dolls. These dolls would probably not appeal to a large audience for the simple reason that they are not the easiest to look at especially for children. I myself found some of them a bit scary to look at. But the pictures made me realize just how different people's minds are and how profoundly people think. Where one person can see beauty another may see evil. For myself, these creations made me think too deeply and at times made me feel uncomfortable. I found myself analyzing each one and wondering what type of person would create this?
